

# **Update – Year 10 starting September 2017**

As your child enters their last term of Year 9 and with September 2017 fast approaching, I am writing to provide you with as much information as possible to ensure the transfer to the UTC is as smooth as possible

## What needs to be done before September and when

Ensure you have attended a meeting with Joanne – can be arranged by calling reception or replying to this email.

Complete the online registration form - as soon as possible, can be found <u>here</u> or we can arrange for a paper version to be sent out to you.

Inform your child's current school that they will be transferring to the UTC from September.

Ensure your child has the correct clothing and equipment, further details below. Your child should attend the Taster Days on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> and Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July, more details below.

Students will need to select their subject options, more details below.

A copy of your child's most recent school report – this can be sent by post, email, dropped in to reception or brought along to the Taster Days. We would like to have received these no later than 4th July 2017.

#### Taster Days – Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> and Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2017

All students joining the UTC in Year 10 must attend the two taster Days. During the days students will complete a variety of activities, ranging from working with industry partners to completing Cognitive Ability Tests (CATS), which will be completed online and do not need any preparation. The CATs will ensure the teachers have more information in readiness for teaching in September.

Students will need to be at the UTC for 9.00am on Monday and 8.30am on Tuesday. Both days activities will formally end at 4.00pm, however on Tuesday we would like to invite parents to join us at 4.00pm for a briefing on activities and final arrangements for September.

Students should dress as close as possible to our Dress Code below but we appreciate that all students may not yet have a formal suit or jacket.

## Curriculum

As you are aware UTC Swindon is a specialist Engineering establishment and therefore our curriculum differs to other schools. All students will study the following Core Curriculum:

Students will have already made initial choices and will need to finalise these by the end of the Taster days in July.
